







WA Wildflowers Tour

Day: 1	Home ~ Perth	D
	<p>You will be met by the awaiting coach crew and transferred to the city of Perth and our accommodation for the next two nights. The rest of the day is yours to either explore the attractions and shopping in the city or maybe just rest up in your room. Enjoy a dinner at the hotel before settling in for the night.</p>	
Day: 2	Swan River cruise ~ Fremantle ~ Perth ~ Free time	BD
	<p>After breakfast at the hotel, we depart and tour the attractions of the city of Perth. Visit the Perth Bell tower at Barrack Street where you can view the ringing of the Swan Bells, the world's largest musical instrument. See historic bells dating back half a century. Board a Captain Cook cruise down the Swan River to the historic port city of Fremantle. Enjoy a Lunch of Cicerello's famous W.A. Fish and Chips. Take time to browse the E-Shed Markets followed by a tour of the W.A. Maritime Museum. Head back along the Coast past the famous Cottesloe Beach to the city where there will be free time to either relax or enjoy the city's shopping precinct before dinner.</p>	
Day: 4	Morowa ~ Mullewa ~ Mingenew ~ Geraldton ~ Kalbarri	BD
	<p>Today, we continue north, through wheat belt regions dotted with wildflowers. Passing by the towns of Morowa, Mullewa and Mingenew we then venture on to Geraldton. Visit the HMAS Sydney memorial in Geraldton before heading north along the spectacular coast to the Coastal resort town of Kalbarri. Visit the Murchison River Gorges before settling into our accommodation and enjoying dinner at the Emanon Restaurant.</p>	
Day: 5	Cervantes	BD
	<p>Enjoy breakfast this morning before cruising on the Murchison River. Leaving the port city of Geraldton, we head south along the coast we take in Dongara, the holiday hotspot on the mid-west coast and then on to Cervantes our overnight stop on the spectacular West Coast. The day will provide plenty of opportunities along the way for us to stop and check out the magnificent wildflowers.</p>	
Day: 6	Pinnacles ~ Perth ~ Mandurah	BD
	<p>This morning we visit the spectacular and well known Pinnacles before travelling south down the coast and back to Western Australia's capital city, Perth. Continuing south, we travel along the Mitchell and Kwinana Freeways to Mandurah and our accommodation for the night.</p>	
Day: 7	Dwellingup ~ Busselton	BD
	<p>An early morning cruise onboard the Mandurah Canal Cruise vessel will give us the opportunity to experience the canals while viewing rows of spectacular multi million dollar mansions backing onto the pristine waterways. Travel up the Darling Range into historic Dwellingup viewing local wildflowers amongst the Jarrah forests. Returning down the escarpment to Pinjarra we travel south to Bunbury and then on to Busselton where we view the spectacular Busselton Jetty, the longest timber jetty in the Southern Hemisphere.</p>	

Day: 8 **Margaret River ~ Cape Leeuwin ~ Pemberton** **BD**



Today we continue to travel south through the world renowned Margaret River wine region. The pristine beach of Yallingup gives way to local vineyards and wineries where some of the world's best wines are produced. After tasting some of the regions wines, we visit the Candy Cow at Cowaramup and for those with a sweet tooth the opportunity to purchase and view an amazing selection of candy. A quick visit to the Margaret River Cheese Co outlet for an opportunity to both taste and purchase locally produced cheeses and yoghurts. The region between Cape Leeuwin and Cape Naturaliste with its high rainfall and close proximity to the coast gives us a unique array of wildflowers to explore. We head inland to Nannup, amongst the towering South West Karri Forests before arriving at our overnight accommodation in the Best Western, Pemberton

Day: 9 **Walpole ~ Denmark ~ Albany** **BD**



Departing Pemberton this morning we head into the South Coast Region of W.A. Stopping at the famous Valley of the Giants Treetop Walk we will view the amazing Karri Trees high above the forest floor. Travelling through the towns of Walpole and Denmark, we continue on to the historic city of Albany and our home for the next 2 nights.

Day: 10 **Albany** **BD**



Today after breakfast we take in the sights of the oldest city in W.A. From Mount Clarence overlooking Albany, take in the spectacular views of Princess Royal Harbour and King George Sound. Travel out across the Torndirrup Peninsula to Whale World, Frenchman Bay, which is located on the site of the old Albany Whaling Station, the last operating whaling station in Australia. Enjoy lunch at the Whaler's cafe (own expense) before visiting the natural wonders of the Blowholes, the Gap, Natural Bridge and the Albany Windfarm at Sandpatch. Enjoy some free time this afternoon to explore Albany.

Day: 11 **Albany ~ Perth** **BD**



Today we head back to Perth. Along the way we will stop at Mount Romance and its Sandalwood Factory for morning tea and a tour. Continuing on our journey we pass the Stirling Ranges, Bluff Knoll (Western Australia's highest mountain), Mount Barker, Kojonup, Arthur River and Williams. Stopping off at the Jadran Winery and the Whistlers Chocolate factory gives us an opportunity to purchase some excellent wines and chocolates to enjoy at our final dinner tonight, where we celebrate our journey with friends both new and old.
